




Charter Membership Requirements

Local / private membership will be selected to best represent the geographic and demographic composition of Maryland. State and federal members will be assumed to represent their entire area of authority. Each agency will be permitted to designate a primary and alternate member. Additional agency representatives are permitted to attend as “information only.” A member’s designation (primary, alternate, information only) is based on their participation in the working group, not on the professional rank within the member’s organization, discipline, or focus area. Primary and alternate members will be endorsed by their respective agency leadership. Members must attend a minimum of 50% of the meetings in any twelve (12) month period. Failure to adhere to this attendance requirement shall result in the member’s replacement.
